Four women combat sex trafficking through an adventure expedition. Join them.

With a spirit of adventure and a heart for the needy, four women banded together to start The Chain Reaction Project (TCRP). The objective: To help change lives in some of the world's least-developed nations.

Since TCRP's launch in 2009, motivational speaker Zhang Tingjun, spinning instructor Alexandra Toh, HR practitioner Jasmine Wong, lawyer Anina Boshoff and their supporters have raised funds for a malnutrition centre in Timor-Leste and helped purchase a plot of land for a Tanzanian orphanage.

This year, the feisty foursome will be embarking on an "Island to Highland" adventure in the

Philippines in May to raise awareness on sex trafficking in Davao city's southern Visayan region. The eight-day trip includes a 24-hour Boulder Face Challenge and/or three-day hike up a potentially active stratovolcano, as well as a visit to non-governmental organisation, Visayan Forum Foundation Inc, to get first-hand accounts from victims and learn about the efforts to halt this organised crime.

Proceeds from the trip will go to Center of Hope, a training and rehabilitation facility that "empowers sex trafficking victims while encouraging social integration".
